



THE LEVITT PAVILION

The Levitt Pavilion brings the magic of music and the performing arts to Arlington in a whole new way – under the stars! The Levitt Pavilion has quickly become the place where families and friends of all ages and backgrounds gather to experience 50 nights of free music, dance and performing arts every year. Their performance schedule includes artists from all around the world and right in their own backyard, from jazz to hot Latin rhythms and world music to children's artists.

The Levitt Pavilion is located in Founders Plaza at the corner of Abram and Center streets, directly across the street from Arlington City Hall, and is available for rent when it is not concert season. The Levitt Pavilion and Founders Plaza are easily accessible for physically challenged patrons. Ramps lead down to the lawn on the Abram Street side of the park. Wheelchairs can be parked all along the sidewalks, and an additional special seating area is wheelchair accessible. Bathrooms are provided on site or in City Hall across Abram Street. The park has WiFi availability for use with phones or computers. There is no smoking on the Levitt Pavilion grounds. Founders Plaza is a city park and falls under the policies of the City of Arlington Parks and Recreation Department.
